- Working closely with Government in development of regulation and implementation of the Charities Act 2006
- Supporting the work of the impACT coalition to achieve greater transparency
- Liaison with government and voluntary sector bodies to improve the environment for fundraisers
- Providing enhanced information and fundraising tools for members of the Institute of Fundraising
