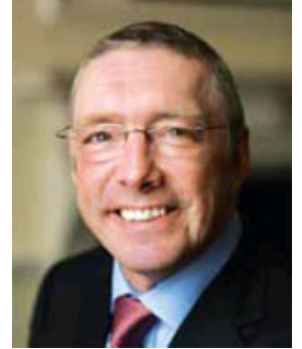
The third sector forms one of the cornerstones of our civic society and much of the credit for that belongs to charity trustees.
